Online applications for students entering Grade 6 in September 2019 can be submitted at any time by visiting <u>https://sd33.bc.ca/registration</u> and select either Chilliwack Middle School (LFI) or Vedder Middle School (LFI) as your school of choice. If the number of applications exceeds the number of spaces available, a lottery system for selection will be used, within the parameters of our Selection Process. All applications received by 12:00 pm on January 28, 2019 will be included in this draw.
