Monday May 11	Warm Up: Use base 10 blocks to <u>draw</u> 457 Puzzle Challenge: Terrific 20! Write down the numbers 1-8 on little slips of paper. Spread them on a table face-up. Pick up 4 papers at a time that add exactly to 20. There are 7 ways to do this - can you find them all?
Tuesday May 12	Warm Up: Use <u>expanded form</u> and a <u>number line</u> to represent 457 Continue the pattern <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 2, 4, 6, _____• 3, 6, 9, _____• 4, 8, 12, _____
Wednesday May 13	Warm Up: Count <u>forward</u> and <u>backwards</u> by 3 starting at 457 . Calculate: $359 + 943 =$ $900 - 375 =$ $768 + 255 =$ $422 - 159 =$
Thursday May 14	Warm Up: Write 3 different <u>equations</u> to equal 457 (+/-). Solve: A farmer has chickens and cows. What combination of animals could total 24 legs? Is there more than one combination?
Friday May 15	Warm Up: Write a <u>word problem</u> that equals 457 . Game: PIG Game. See attached sheet for rules

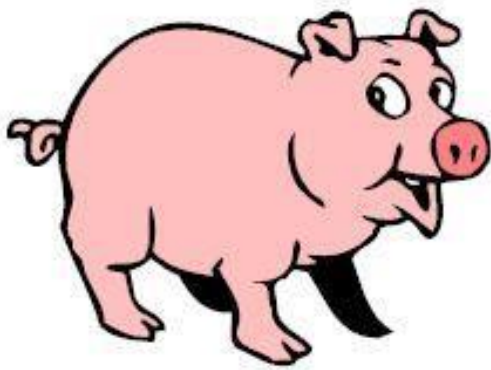

PIG

Players: 2

Materials: 1 or 2 dice, 120 chart (optional)

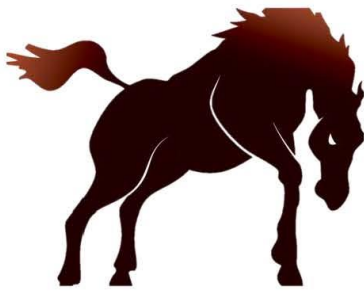
Object: Be the first player to reach 100

One Die Version: On a turn, a player can roll repeatedly until one of two things happens (1) the player rolls a 1 or (2) the player chooses to hold (stop rolling). Each number rolled is added to the player's total. If a 1 is rolled, all points for that turn are lost!

Scoring examples:

1. Suzy rolls a 4 and decides to continue. She then rolls 5 more times (3, 4, 2, 6, 1). Because she rolled a 1, her turn ends and she receives no points for the numbers rolled.
2. Marcus rolls a 6 and decides to continue. He rolls 3 more times (4, 3, 5) and decides to hold. His score for the round is 18 ($6 + 4 + 3 + 5 = 18$).

Two Dice Version: Two dice are rolled. If a single 1 is rolled on either dice, the turn ends and all points are lost. If two 1s are rolled on a single turn, the player scores 25 points. Doubles, for example a 2 and a 2, are worth double points ($4 \times 2 = 8$).
