Number Sense – 1-20

Create a number strip 1 to 20. Using two dices, roll first die, place die above the number representing the dots, roll second die and place above the number, make number sentence ($__ + __ = __$)

Patterns –

Collect small household items – buttons, beads, toothpicks, etc.

Create simple patterns – aabb, aab, aabbc,

Copy the patterns and label

Review Letter A-Z (see, say, read & print)

Read together (yellow WB)

June 9, 2020

Print and Review Letters A-Z (name & sounds)
Print letters A-Z in printing WB
Directed Drawing – butterflies (life cycle)

Wednesday
June 10, 2020

Phonemic Lesson – (Blending Game)
Say "I am thinking of a word that makes these sounds." /b/ /a/ /t/
"What is my word?" (bat) Give at least 10 words to solve. Do activity sheet – relating to first and ending sounds.

Thursday
June 11, 2020

Journal writing – When I Grow Up (worksheet)
Encourage your child to print the letters they heard. If this is not possible, then you can write it down for them but they still have to tell you the letters they heard.

June 12, 2020

Reading Day
Find a quiet spot to view books or read aloud to a partner.
